- Current Alaska Certification as a Medical Assistant, or
- Equivalent Military Experience, or
- Completion of first semester of clinical coursework in an accredited nursing program.
- Formal training in Nonviolent Crisis Prevention (CPI) must be completed within 6 months of hire.
